The neighborhood was officially allocated to the Malays and others in the Muslim community, including a small but successful community of Arab traders. Admire the majestic Sultan Mosque, which is one of the most important mosques on the island of Singapore. Then enjoy a stroll through the Arab district. Next, walk through the busy streets of Chinatown where you get to see heritage shop houses, traditional Chinese medicine halls, and other local shops.

Little India completes the cultural kaleidoscope with its bustling streets

showcasing aromatic and exotic spices, colorful flower-garland shops, vegetable vendors and busy curry houess. The tour will end at Tekka Centre, part wet market, part food center and part shopping mall, where several ethnic communities converge to create a multicultural shopping fiesta. – entrance to Pinnacle included.
